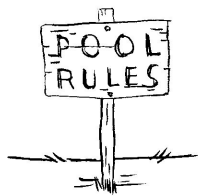

## POOL RULES

The swimming pools will be open on or around Memorial Day weekend (please check Facebook or call the office for an exact date). You are welcome to use the pools from dawn until dusk every day. You may leave your chair under the deck, or at the cabana in Pine Tree Gardens. Mayfair is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Residents must ALWAYS accompany their guests (limit 2 guests per adult resident). Children must be supervised at ALL times. No screaming, diving, cannon-balling, frisbee, ball playing or floats are allowed. Only potty trained children are allowed. No life guard is provided - you swim at your own risk. No glass containers are allowed near the pool. Pool gates must be closed at all times. Please do not prop open the gates or clubhouse doors. Please do not smoke in the gated area of the pool. As always, please be respectful of your neighbors and enjoy the upcoming summer season.

### PESTO SHRIMP SKEWERS

#### *Ingredients:*

- \*1 lb medium large frozen shrimp, deveined & thawed
- \*3 lemons, thinly sliced sliced
- \*8 skewers, soaked in water 20 minutes
- \*extra virgin olive oil for drizzling
- \*kosher salt
- \*freshly ground black pepper
- \*½ cup pesto



#### *Directions:*

1. Preheat grill to medium-high. Skewer shrimp and lemon slice. Drizzle with olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Grill, turning occasionally, until shrimp is opaque and lemons slightly charred, 4-5 minutes
2. Brush with pesto and serve.
