Wednesday, June 27th

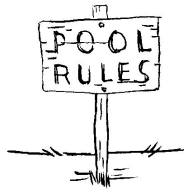

POOL RULES

The swimming pools will be open on or around Memorial Day weekend (please check Facebook or call the office for an exact date). You are welcome to use the pools from dawn until dusk every day. You may leave your chair under the deck, or at the cabana in Pine Tree Gardens. Mayfair is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Residents must ALWAYS accompany their guests (limit 2 guests per adult resident). Children must be supervised at ALL times. No screaming, diving, cannon-balling, frisbee, ball playing or floats are allowed. Only potty trained children are allowed. No life guard is provided - you swim at your own risk. No glass containers are allowed near the pool. Pool gates must be closed at all times. Please do not prop open the gates or clubhouse doors. Please do not smoke in the gated area of the pool. As always, please be respectful of your neighbors and enjoy the upcoming summer season.

PUMPKIN FESTIVAL

Saturday, October 20th - Putnam, CT.

It's not too early to be thinking about beautiful fall foliage and wonderful New England fall festivals. We are thrilled to announce that our fall trip this year will take us on a train ride adventure to the Great Pumpkin Festival in Putnam, CT.

We will *carpool* from Foxboro to the historic Blackstone Valley Train Depot in Woonsocket, RI. From here we will take a relaxing train ride through the Blackstone Valley National Heritage Corridor to Putnam's Great Pumpkin Festival where there'll be an array of family friendly activities; Annual Scarecrow contest, craft and art vendors, live music, antiques merchants, local restaurants and much more!

We will leave Foxboro at 7:30AM and head to Woonsocket. At 9AM the scenic two hour train ride departs for Putnam, CT. We will have approximately 3.5 hours at the festival before boarding the train again at 2:30PM.

BLUEBERRY LEMONADE

Ingredients:

*1/2 cup extra fine granulated sugar

*1 cup blueberries

*3/4 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice



Directions:

1. To make the blueberry simple syrup, combine sugar and 1 cup water in a medium saucepan over medium heat, stirring until the sugar has dissolved. Stir in blueberries and bring to a boil; reduce heat and simmer until blueberries have broken down, about 3-4 minutes.
2. Strain blueberry mixture through a cheesecloth or fine sieve; let cool.
3. In a large pitcher, whisk together blueberry simple syrup, lemon juice and 5 cups water. Place in the refrigerator until chilled.
4. Serve over ice and blueberries, if desired.
