
WINTER PARKING BAN NOW IN EFFECT

Winter is just around the corner and we'd like to briefly touch upon snow removal expectations: Please do not move your vehicle out of your parking space until you have been requested to do so by a Mayfair employee; When we knock on your door to move your vehicle, please do so quickly; Stay in your vehicle until we have finished plowing your parking lot; Please park your vehicle back in your parking lot as soon as we are done plowing it. *It is imperative that no vehicles are left on the street as they impede the ability of emergency vehicles gaining access to your building as well as your neighbors.* Thank you, in advance, for your cooperation.

SNOW REMOVAL FORMS

Available to elderly residents and/or disabled residents *who are not physically capable* of moving their own vehicle for plowing. Please stop in the office and sign a release form to allow us to move your vehicle for you.

Snow removal needs to be a cooperative effort between our staff and our residents. It also needs to be a cooperative effort between you and your neighbors.



WINTER VACATION FORMS

Available to all residents who plan to leave for an entire month during December, January, February and/or March. To qualify for this \$15/month credit, you have to be away the first through the last day of the month. We ask that you turn your heat down to 55 degrees and make sure you lock up your apartment before leaving. If you turn off your refrigerator, please make sure that you leave the door open so that mildew does not develop in the unit. For snow removal purposes, please let us know if you plan to leave your car. If so, we'd suggest that you ask a neighbor to move it for you when we have to plow.

SWEET POTATO PECAN ROUNDS

Ingredients:

- *3 large sweet potatoes - washed & sliced into ½ inch thick pieces
- *1 tbs olive oil
- *1 tsp whipped cream cheese per potato slice
- *roughly chopped roasted pecans
- *salt & pepper to taste



Instructions:

1. Arrange potato slices on a large sheet tray. Toss with olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Roast at 375 ° for 40 minutes, flipping them halfway through, until they're soft and golden brown in places.
2. Cool slightly, then spread each slice with 1 tsp of whipped cream cheese, at room temperature. Sprinkle with roughly chopped pecans and serve.
