BALSAMIC CRANBERRY-ONION JAM

Ingredients:

*1/3 cup extra virgin olive oil *4 cups chopped sweet onions

*1 (12 oz) pkg. fresh or frozen cranberries,

thawed

*1 tbs. balsamic vinegar

Directions:

- 1. Heat oil in a large heavy saucepan over medium heat. Add onions and salt cover and cook 30 minutes or until caramelized. Add honey, pepper, thyme, and cranberries; cook, uncovered, 30 minutes or until cranberries break down and mixture is syrupy.
- 2. Remove pan from heat; discard thyme sprigs. Stir in vinegar.
