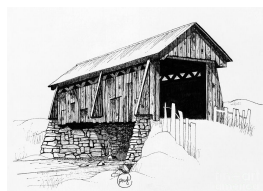

GARLIC MUSHROOM QUINOA

Ingredients:

- *1 cup quinoa
- *1 tbs olive oil
- *1 lb cremini mushrooms, thinly sliced
- *5 cloves garlic, minced
- *½ teaspoon dried thyme
- *kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- *2 tbs grated parmesan



Directions:

1. In a large saucepan cook quinoa according to package instructions.
2. Heat olive oil in a large skillet over medium high heat. Add mushrooms, garlic & thyme. Cook, stirring occasionally, until tender (about 3-4 minutes). Season with salt and pepper, to taste. Stir in quinoa until well combine.
3. Serve immediately, garnished with parmesan, if desired.
