## GOAT CHEESE AND BASIL DIP WITH HONEY

### *Ingredients:*

- \*4 oz goat cheese
- \*6 fresh basil leaves
- \*2 tablespoons honey
- \*1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- \*1 tablespoon sunflower seeds
- \*1 french baguette sliced and toasted



### *Instructions:*

1. Spread the goat cheese on a serving platter or plate, using the back of a spoon to make it smooth and even. Chop or shred the basil leaves and sprinkle on the goat cheese. Drizzle the honey and balsamic vinegar evenly over the cheese. Top with sunflower seeds.
2. Serve immediately with toasted bread and enjoy!
