## PLYMOUTH HARBOR CRUISE


### ~PILGRIM BELLE TOUR~

## OLD BAY SHRIMP

Ingredients:

- \* 1 ½ lb. shell-on deveined shrimp (16 -20 ct.)
- \* 1 tbsp. olive oil
- \* 3 tsp. Old Bay seasoning
- \* ¼ cup chopped parsley

Instructions:

1. Heat grill on high. Toss shrimp with olive oil and 1 ½ tsp Old Bay seasoning.
2. Thread shrimp onto skewer and grill until opaque, turning over once, 3 to 5 minutes.
3. Remove shrimp from skewers and transfer to large bowl. Sprinkle with parsley and 1 ½ tsp. Old Bay seasoning; toss to combine. Serve immediately.
