Lenny Clarke is best known in the entertainment world for his sarcastic social commentaries, anecdotal humor and thick Boston accent, along with his role as Uncle Teddy on FX’s hit series, *Rescue Me*. He has also starred in his own sitcom, *Lenny*. On the big screen, he can be seen in such films as *Monument Ave*, *Fever Pitch* and *Southie*.

Most recently he appeared in the feature film *Here Comes The Boom* with Kevin James and Salma Hayek. Clarkes’ status as the most famous “saloon comic” in Boston during the 80’s was captured in the 2006 documentary, *When Standup Stood Out*. The tale details his early career and affiliations with other Boston comics, such as good friends Steven Wright and Denis Leary.

- \* Do not leave any personal items or trash in common areas (yard, street, parking lot, hallways, basement, etc.).
- \* Yard sale is for Mayfair residents only.

## POOL RULES

The swimming pools will be open on or around Memorial Day weekend (please check Facebook or call the office for an exact date). You are welcome to use the pools from dawn until dusk every day. You may leave your chair under the deck, or at the cabana in Pine Tree Gardens. Mayfair is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Residents must ALWAYS accompany their guests (limit 2 guests per household). Children must be supervised at ALL times. No diving, cannon-balling, frisbee, ball playing or floats are allowed. Only potty trained children are allowed. No life guard is provided - you swim at your own risk. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area. Pool gates must be closed at all times. Please do not prop open the gates or clubhouse doors. Smoking is not permitted in or around the pool areas. As always, please be respectful of your neighbors and enjoy the upcoming summer season.

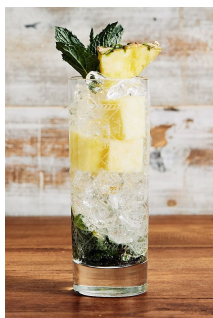
## FOX-IN-THE-BORO

## Pineapple Mojito

Ingredients:

- 1.5 oz. spiced rum
- .5 oz. lime juice
- 4 cubers sugar
- 4 pieces pineapple
- 10 mint leaves



Instructions:
